

2008 PERFORMANCE TICKET SALES

Yes...It's almost performance time and tickets will go on sale Sunday, May 4th at 8am at the Dance Affair. Ticket sales will continue through June. Office hours will be posted in the lobby area as well as on the front door.

To keep ticket sales fair and to offer everyone an equal opportunity to purchase the tickets of their choice, I'd like to quickly explain how the sales will work:

On Sunday May 4th: Arrivals before 7:30am will not be honored.

There will be no overnight waiting. We ask that no parents or family members arrive until 7:30am Sunday morning. Anyone arriving earlier than that will NOT be given a number. We ask that you please honor this as we would like to respect our neighbors. We are not trying to make this a fight for first place as we feel there are enough seats for everyone. Please help us out by making this a smooth and pleasant day. The Dance Affair cannot be liable for any accidents or injury that may occur while waiting in the ticket line.

Upon arrival at the studio, you will receive a number (first come first serve) according to your place in line. We will begin to hand out numbers at 7:30am and, to keep things fair, only one number will be given to each family. You may not purchase tickets for other families at the studio. Each family must purchase their own tickets. Once you receive a number, you are free to wait at the studio until your number is called (numbers will be called in order) or you can leave and come back if you choose to do so. Unfortunately, if your number is called and you are **not** at the studio, we cannot wait for you to arrive. If we pass your number and you are not around, you will need to get a new number and start the process all over again.

When your number is called, we will show you the Performing Arts Center seating chart and which tickets are still available. Ticket prices range from \$20-\$25 depending on seating area. We accept cash, check, or charge and all tickets must be paid for in full at the time of purchase. *Sorry, no IOUs!* A list will be available showing any credit or debit balance you may have on account. The credits can be used towards your ticket purchase. *Please have your tuition current to avoid any discrepancies as any outstanding balances will also be collected at this time.*

Please remember that each family is asked to purchase a minimum of 10 tickets OR you can do a buy-out. The following is a breakdown of purchase options: Ten (10) tickets @ \$20 = \$200 or @ \$25 = \$250 or any combination thereof, four (4) \$20 tickets for \$120. Two (2) \$20 tickets for \$80

BUYING TICKETS FROM ANOTHER PERSON AT THE STUDIO DOES NOT FULFIL YOUR REQUIREMENT TO PURCHASE TICKETS. You will be asked to purchase your family minimum to help out with the rental of the facility. On the first day of sales each family may purchase 10 tickets. You may buy up to 10 tickets in the orchestra section or 10 in the grand tier or main floor seating areas. You may purchase a few tickets in each area as long as it adds up to 10 tickets or you can do the BUY OUT in the rows 21 and up the Grand Tier (balcony). You may continue to purchase tickets throughout the months of May and June if you need more. We appreciate your support of the show. Your ticket purchase goes towards the rental of the Performing Arts Center, the lighting & sound crew, the theater ushers and the many props that are used during the show.

Remember...there really are no bad seats! Even if you are seated on the side, you are still able to see the stage perfectly.

The staff and I would like to thank you for your efforts in making this year's show a success.
